Naturist Etiquette

Be Friendly. Introduce yourself to people you don't know.

If you plan to enjoy the pool or hot **tub** *do not* apply oil or sunscreen before you get in, unless it is the waterproof kind. It makes maintenance of those facilities extremely difficult.

Bring two towels--one with which to sit on the furniture, and one to dry on.
